Book Adventure allows the children to create their own book lists according to their interests, take multiple choice quizzes on the books they've read offline, and earn points and prizes for their literary successes.

Each student should choose one of the books they read over the summer. They should fill out the attached book report form using neat printing, writing in complete sentences and coloring the picture neatly.

The book report and list of books read are due the first week of school.
