Upcoming 3rd Grade**

It is important for children to maintain their reading skills throughout the summer. We encourage various reading materials (books of good length (50+ pages), fiction, non-fiction, magazines, newspapers ...to be read during the summer. We rely on parent's judgment to assist their child in choosing age appropriate and reading level materials. We recommend upcoming 3rd graders to read between 10-15 books over the summer. Please keep a list of books read on the attached sheet.

Take advantage of our local library's summer reading program or Book Adventure ([www.bookadventure.com](http://www.bookadventure.com)). Book Adventure allows the children to create their own book lists according to their interests, take multiple choice quizzes on the books they've read offline, and earn points and prizes for their literary successes.

Each student will need to choose one of the following Magic Tree House books: Dolphins at Daybreak, Ghost Town at Sundown, Lions at Lunchtime, or Polar Bears Past Bedtime and fill out the attached book report form. Third grade teachers recommend that students read the Magic Tree House book later in the summer. This series of stories will be discussed during the first week of school.

The book report and list of books read are due the first week of school. The book report will count as a grade in reading.

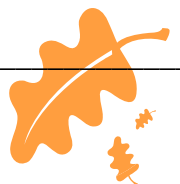
